The Wine Runs Out

Miracles of Jesus – Name some of Jesus' miracles (There are approximately 40 recorded)

He changed the water into wine (John 2:1-11) He healed a leper (Mark 1:40-45) He raised the widow's son from the dead (Luke 7:11-18) He stilled the storm (Matthew 8:23-27) Walked on water He cured two demoniacs (Matthew 8:28-34) He raised the ruler's daughter from the dead (Matthew 9:18-26) He opened the eyes of two blind men (Matthew 9:27-31) He loosened the tongue of a dumb man (Matthew 9:32,33) He restored a withered hand (Matthew 12:10-13) He fed five thousand people (Matthew 14:15-21) He opened the eyes of a man born blind (John 11:1-38) He raised Lazarus from the dead (John 11:1-46)
