How tall were people in ancient times

In Jesus' time, there was a requirement that all Roman soldiers had to be at least 5-10...so they seem to have been about the same height as men today.

The average height of ancient Egyptian males was 5' 3 and 5' 0 for women.

Human remains from ancient Greece and Turkey have revealed that the average height of hunter-gatherers was 5 feet, 9 inches for men and 5 feet, 5 inches for women. However, the switch to an agricultural economy led to a fall in average height by 3000 B.C.--to 5 feet, 3 inches and 5 feet exactly, respectively, for men and women.
