Jesus Heals Demon Possessed Man

- Jesus goes to Capernaum and teaches in the synagogue on the Sabbath
- A man with a demon cries out, "What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are – the Holy One of God!"
- Jesus rebukes the evil spirit and it comes out of him with a shriek.
- The people in the synagogue ask, "What is this? A new teaching and with authority! He even gives orders to evil spirits and they obey him."
- News about Jesus spreads quickly over the whole region of Galilee.

Jesus Heals Man with Leprosy

- A man covered with leprosy approaches Jesus.
 - There are various forms of the disease, but white leprosy seemed most common among the Hebrews. With it the sufferer became white from head to foot.
- He begged Jesus to heal him with his face to the ground.
- . 10-13
- Jesus touches the leper and heals him. To touch a leper was forbidden, and carried ceremonial defilement, but at the touch of Jesus the source of the defilement fled.
- Jesus tells the man not to tell anyone but to show himself to the priest.

Jesus Heals Peter's Mother-in-Law

- Jesus goes to the house of Peter.
- He sees Peter's mother-in-law in bed with a fever.
- Jesus heals her and she gets up and waits on them.
- When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him and drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.

Discussion Question – How can we reach out to outcast people like Jesus did to bring them healing?
