Jesus is Questioned







Luke 6:1-2

Jesus Answers Them







Luke 6:3-4

Luke 6:5


Then Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."




Jesus Heals on the Sabbath



Jesus Teaches in the Synagogue






Matthew 12:9

Jesus Asks the Pharisees a Question







Matthew 12:11-12

Jesus Heals the Man







Matthew 12:13

Pharisees are Furious









The Pharisees were furious and began to plot ways how they might kill Jesus.
