Judges 6:33-7:25

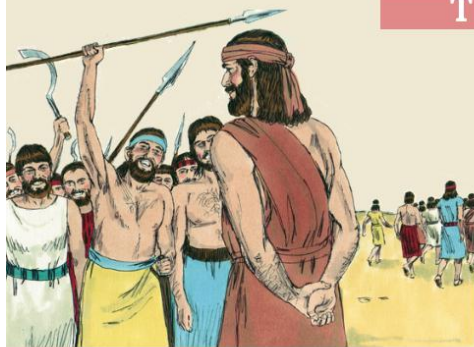
Now all the Midianites, Amalekites and other eastern peoples joined forces and crossed over the Jordan and camped in the Valley of Jezreel.

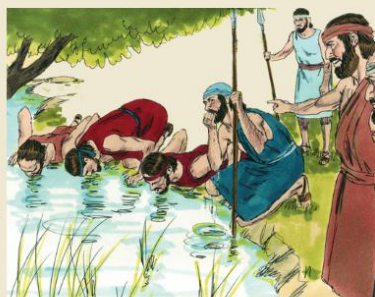
Too Many Men



God told Gideon he had too many men. Anyone who trembled with fear could go home; 22,000 left and 10,000 remained.

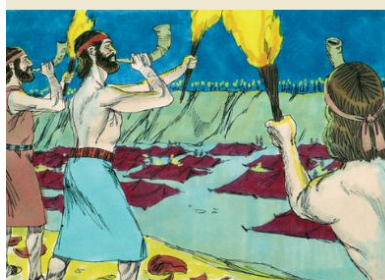
Still Too Many

God told Gideon he still had too many men. He told Gideon to separate those who lap water with their tongues like a dog from those who kneel down to drink, 300 lapped with their hands to their mouths. Using these 300 men, God told Gideon he would defeat the Midianites.
