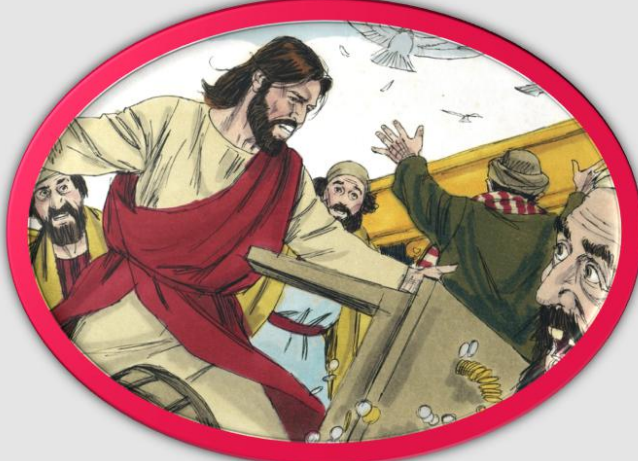


JESUS CLEARS THE TEMPLE

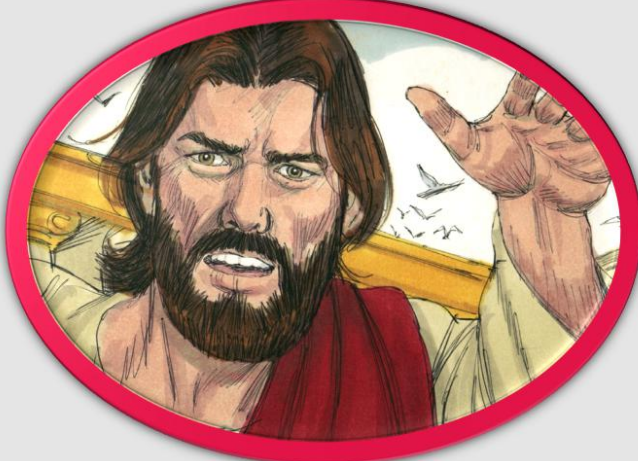
John 2:13-16
