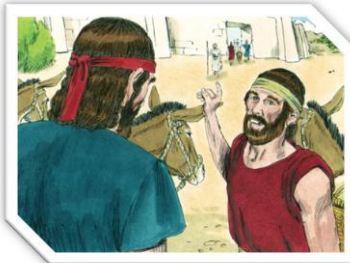


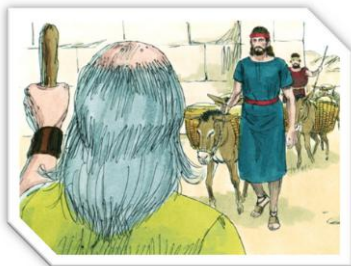
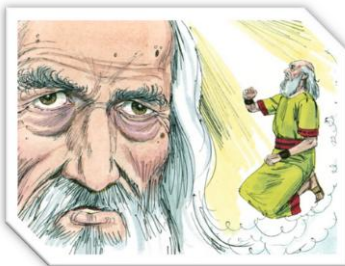
SAUL IS MADE KING

1 SAMUEL 9:1 - 10:1



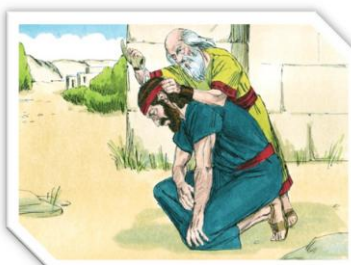
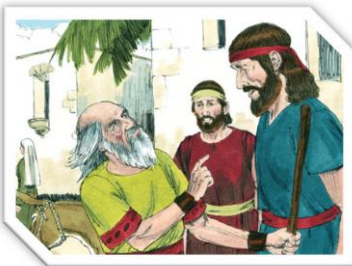
