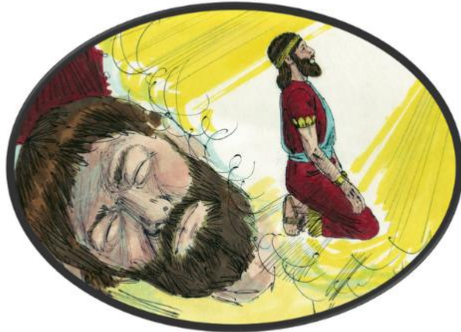


THE WISDOM OF SOLOMON
