

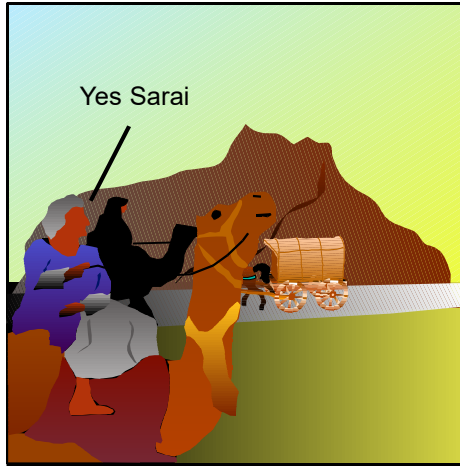
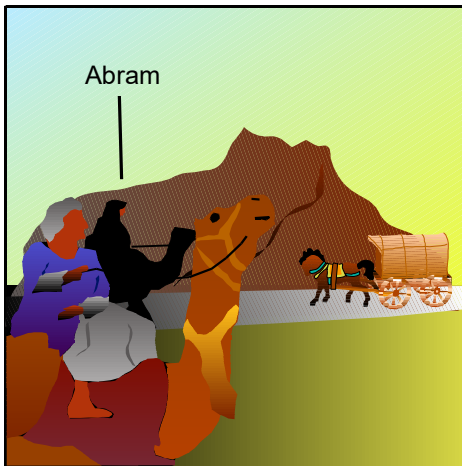
God's Promise to Abraham
