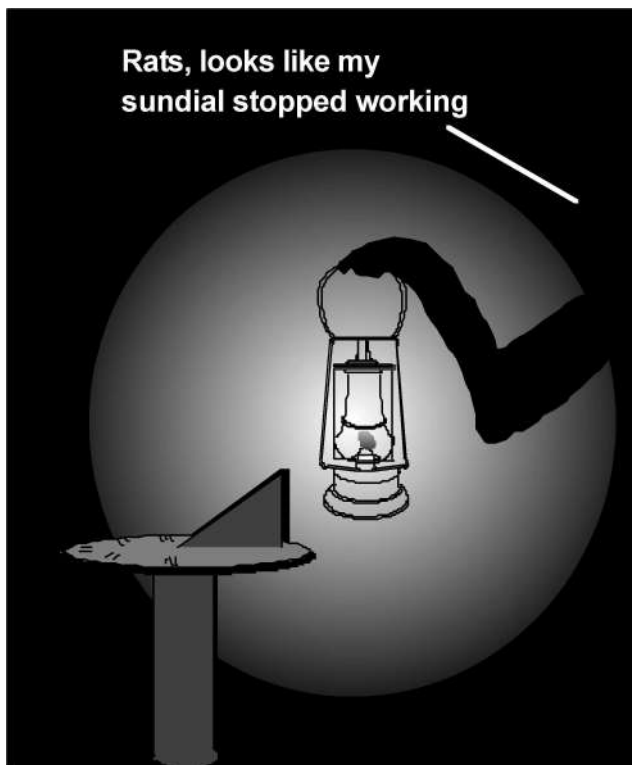
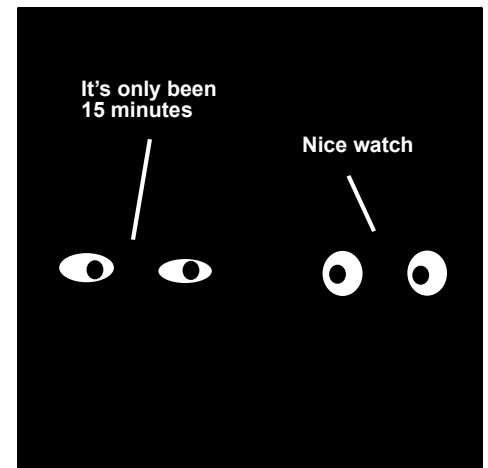


Plague of Darkness
