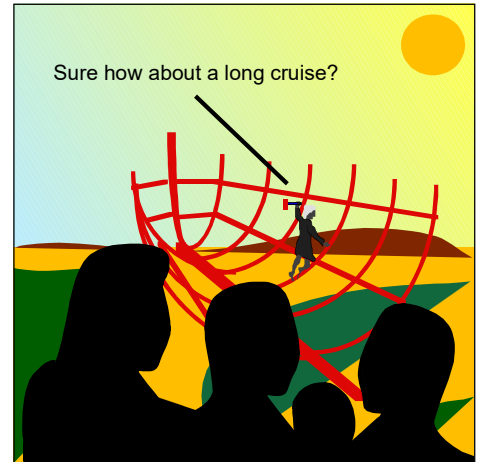
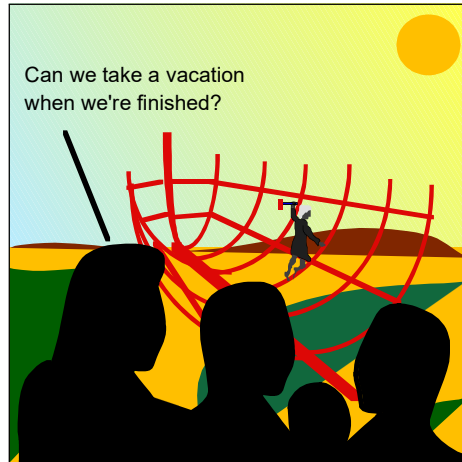
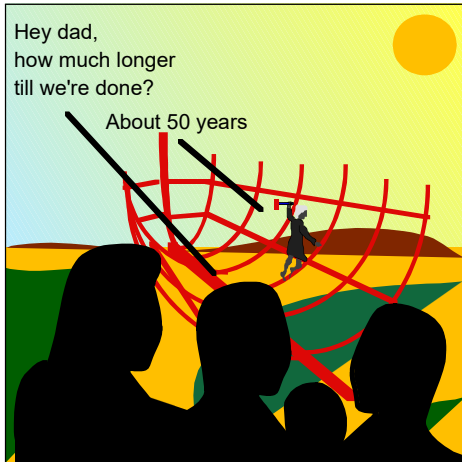


Noah's Persistence
