

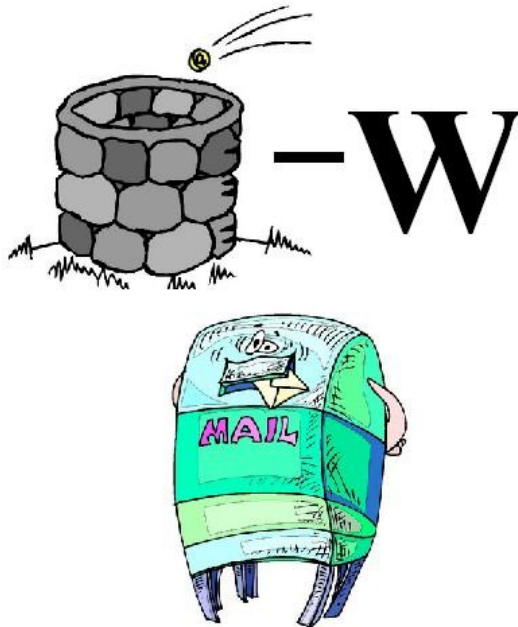

Fun Bible Facts Clothing

The Bible covers a time span of several thousand years, but the type of clothing worn by most Jewish people during that time did not change much.

The main garment, worn by both women and men, was a tunic. This was made of two rectangular pieces of cloth joined in a long seam along the top of the arms, with a hole left for the head to go through. It also had a seam running down both sides, with holes left for the arms.

The tunic was worn with a belt, either leather or metal, the decoration depending on the wealth of the wearer.

A cloak could be worn over the tunic. The edges and fringes of the cloak were often decorated.
