

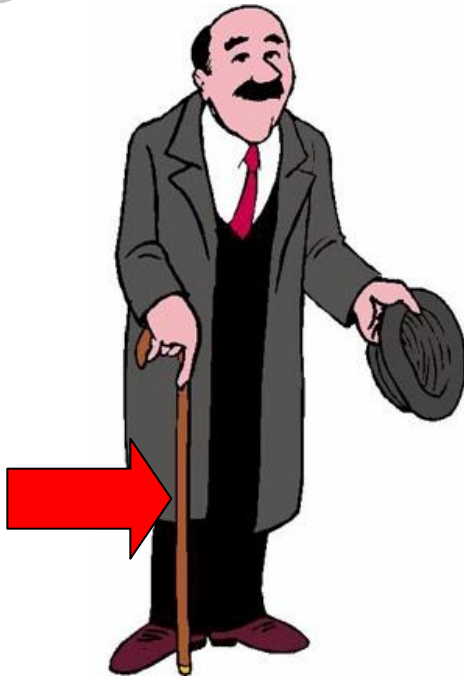

Fun Bible Facts References to running in the Bible

The words for "run" and "race" (Greek trecho and dromos) sometimes clearly, and in other cases probably, allude to foot-races at the games.

For obvious references compare 1 Cor 9:24; Heb 12:1; 2 Tim 4:7;

For possible references see Acts 20:24; Gal 2:2; 5:7; Phil 2:16.

The goal of the foot-race, a square pillar at the end of the stadium opposite the entrance, which the athlete as far as possible kept in view and the sight of which encouraged him to redouble his efforts, is alluded to once: "I press on toward the goal" (Phil 3:14).
