Fun Bible Facts Horses in the Bible

Evidence indicates that the horse was introduced into the Middle East two thousand years before Christ. The horse is mentioned more than 150 times in the Bible, with the earliest reference being found in Genesis 47:17. However, there is no indication that the horse was in common use in Israel until the time of David and Solomon.

The number of horses owned by Solomon was as many as twelve thousand. They were used to draw chariots (1 Kings 4:26; 1 Kings 10:26).

Solomon imported horses from Egypt (Deuteronomy 17:16; 2 Chronicles 1:16). The ruins of Solomon's well-known horse stables at ancient Megiddo are today marked as an historical and archeological site.
